# Conditions of Entry

This Competition shall be conducted under the rules of the Piping & Dancing Assn of NZ except for No's 0, 15 & 26. Every competitor shall produce a membership certificate for the current year when asked to do so and if unable to do so may be required to apply for membership forthwith.

P&D Rules relating to Pipers Dress will be adhered to. In the event of a tie for a trophy aggregate marks will be used.

- **Rule 37 regarding tuning will be enforced.** Competitors risk disqualification if they are not ready to play when called upon.
- No New Zealand, North Island or Centre Championship shall be awarded unless there are not fewer than 5 competitors in the event and the Judge certifies the winning performance is of standard to merit the award of the Championship.

**Competitors MUST report to Board Stewards at least 5 minutes prior to each event, otherwise their right to compete may be forfeited. Tuning time at the board will be at the judge's discretion.**

**All events: 3 entries - 1<sup>st</sup> Prize only awarded.**

**5 entries - 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Prizes awarded.**

**7 entries - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Prizes awarded.**

**15 or more entries - A 4<sup>th</sup> Prize will be awarded**

NOTE: Any competitor who is a previous winner of D Grade events is advised to enter other grades

**Note: No Animals are allowed into the Caledonian Park.

# GENERAL PIPING NOTES

- Event 0 Music: Own choice of any tunes lasting no less than 6 minutes and no more than 8 minutes
- All Premier & Open Grade events require three tunes of each time signature to be submitted to the Board Steward on the day of competition.
- B Grade competitors must submit 2 x tunes each event. Judges nominate which tune to play.
- Under 21 events require 2 x tunes in each event to be submitted to Board Steward prior to event.
- Novice Event is for competitors who have not won a Novice competition before.
- Pipers may enter in their own grade and one above.
- Event 15. Music: Own choice. Minimum playing time of 3 minutes - maximum 5 minutes.
- Winning Pipers MUST wear correct Highland dress for Trophy presentation.
- All major trophies will be presented on the main stage at the end of the day.
- Points are allocated according to NZ P&D association. 5 for first, 3 for second & 1 for third.

**All Trophies are to be retuned fully polished and with your name engraved on it. Trophies can be returned either to the Chief Piping Steward's office on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 or couriered to the Waipu Caledonian Society by the 30<sup>th</sup> of October if you are not attending the 2022 Waipu Highland Games.**

The U21 Piobaireachd event will be held in conjunction with the B Grade Piobaireachd. **Prize Money will be awarded in both classes and U21 Competitors can pay & compete for both events in this competition.** The second event for WBM scholarship competitors will be the U21 2/4 March. **The first four place-getters in these TWO events will qualify for WBM Scholarship placing.**
